Matthew 8:23-27, Mark 4:35-41, Luke 8:22-25

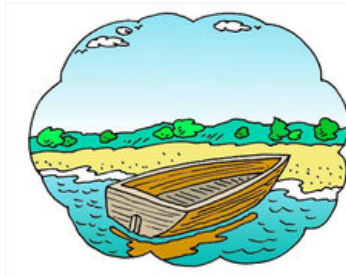

- 1 This story is written about in three books of the Bible - Matthew, Mark and Luke.
